Paul is a Director of the Prague office of Jacobs Consultancy leading the transport consultancy activities and developing business opportunities in continental Europe. He has varied experience of strategic transport and ITS planning/research, management of externally funded programmes and consultancy in the area of European Union structural funds.

In the last few years he has managed innovative projects for example in the area of modelling, economic justification and impact analysis of ITS investments such as a Czech VMS travel information services and ATM schemes for the M80 in Scotland and the M42 in the Midlands. Since 2006 he has led Jacobs Consultancy as the chief consultant to the Czech Ministry of Transport for evaluation methodology and approval of all applications made for funds from the Czech Operational Transport Programme. He has also led Jacobs management of Czech input to the Euroregional TEN-T ITS development programme EasyWay funded by the EU, has been coordinator of the European Study Group on European ITS solutions for freight and logistics management and an active member of the EasyWay European Evaluation Expert Group. He has organized and run a number of local and international workshops with the aim of developing multi-disciplinary strategic materials utilizing the know-how of renowned experts from various sectors or understanding the user needs of practical stakeholders for various ITS applications (e.g. for transport information systems).
